We are hoping to keep the sale very easy and organized, so if you are wanting to participate, PLEASE CAREFULLY READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS:

*If you want us to keep track of the items of yours that have sold: Please tape an envelope or post-it on the outside or inside of EACH book or item that you want to sell, and include the following information: **your name, selling price and name of the book** – remember one envelope or post-it is needed for each item. The envelope or post-it will be collected at the time of sale and given back to you so you can know which items of yours were sold

*If you want to collect your money for your sold items, but you don't need record of which specific things sold: Put a small sticker or piece of tape on each item the the following information; **your name, and selling price**.

* If your items are not individually, clearly marked, the money made by their sale will be donated to our Connections account.

Your money will be collected for you and able to pick up at the end of the sale. Also, please remember to pick up your unsold books after the sale that same day! Any items left behind will be donated immediately following the sale.
